DODGEBALL 2021

Game Play:

- During pool play, rules will be enforced by the "Honor System." Players will be expected to rule whether or not a hit was legal or whether they were legally eliminated. If teams cannot agree, then court supervisor will rule on the situation. THE COURT SUPERVISOR IS FINAL - NO EXCEPTIONS. (During the tournament play, a minimum of 2 refs will make the calls.)
- 2. You are "OUT" if:
 - You are hit anywhere on your shoulders and below. It must be a solid hit.
 - You touch or cross the center line.
 - The opposing team catches your ball before it touches the ground, wall, another player or another players ball. This is called a "LIVE" ball.
 - You throw the ball out of the arena.
 - You block the ball and drop your ball in the process.
 - You are hit and the ball hits the wall, but you still catch it.
- 3. You are "NOT OUT" if:
 - The ball bounces and hits you.
 - The ball hits the wall and hits you.
 - The ball hits another player's ball and hits you.
 - The ball hits another player and hits you.
 - The ball hits you and YOU catch it.
 - The ball hits you and a teammate catches it.
- 4. When you are in the "OUT BOX":
 - Form a line in the order of which you are "OUT", the first person out is the next person "IN."
 - Do not leave the box area unless someone on your team catches the opposing teams "LIVE" ball and you are next in.

Game is over when all players from one team is eliminated or time runs out. Each pool play match will have a 5 minutes time limit. The tournament play will play out until all players are eliminated.
